

# Comment faire les accents sur son ordinateur?

## 1) Using the ALT key on your numerical pad keyboard

Here's a chart of the most commonly used French symbols

Symbol	Lower case	Upper Case
Accent grave (à)	ALT + 133	ALT + 0192
Circumflexe (â)	ALT + 131	ALT + 0194
Cedille (ç )	ALT + 135	ALT + 128
Accent Aigu (é)	ALT + 130	ALT + 144
Accent Grave (è )	ALT + 138	ALT + 0200
Circumflexe ( ê )	ALT + 136	ALT + 0202
Circumflexe ( î )	ALT + 140	ALT + 0206
Circumflexe ( ô )	ALT + 147	ALT + 0212
e dans l'o (œ )	ALT + 0156	ALT + 0140
Accent Grave (ù )	ALT + 151	ALT + 0217
Circumflexe ( û )	ALT + 150	ALT + 0219
French accents - left «	ALT + 174	
French accents – right »		ALT + 175
Euro €	ALT + 0128	

## 2. Configuring your keyboard

**Note: This will not change your keyboard into another language, it will just enable you to type accents by using your initial keyboard.**

Go to the Menu of your computer (Windows waffle in the start menu) and in the search box, type "Region and language settings"

In the section "Languages", your computer should be set up to use "English".

Click on "English (United States) and then click on "options"

In the section KEYBOARDS, click on **Add a keyboard**, and select "**United States International**".

Once you select it, you will see a language bar in the lower right corner of your computer next to the battery indicator.

The keys to use on the computer

Take the time to observe your keyboard and locate the four keys you will need to use:

→The accent grave located left of 1

→The accent circonflexe located on the key 6

→The accent aigu located left of Enter

→The tréma located at the right of the L

Ç (cédille)	Press key left of Enter and then press the letter "c"
é (accent aigu)	Press key left of Enter and then press the letter "e"
è (accent grave)	Press key left of 1 and then press the letter "e"
ë (tréma)	Press at the same time "shift + key after L" then press the letter "e"
ê (accent circonflexe)	Press at the same time "Shift + key 6" then press the letter "e"
