CONTENT

Only photos /

Text should only be the name of your francophone city, the names of your hotel(s), airport or station, bus line name, subway stops, restaurants..... / In print can be in French the sequence of days (day 1 / day 2 / day 3...)

Slide 1: Introduce the city, map, flag, global dates of the stay, weather at those dates / Mention budget

Slide 2: You pack your suitcase (list of flashcards or photos showing what you will pack)

Slide 3: Traveling → Show what transportation you took, the places you departed and arrived. If you needed to take another means of transportation connecting to an airport or a train station upon your arrival, explain your peers how you arrived to your city.

Show tickets / cost of tickets

Slide 4: Explain where you stayed, the type of room you booked and how much you spent

Following slides 5→12 should contain activities you did and places you went / where you ate / Include also the costs per item

Travel journal:

Give an account of 40 words minimum of your travel per each day of traveling. You should have 10 paragraphs per small travel guide page.

Write complete sentences.

Use a maximum of vocabulary from chapter. Use the past tense. Check spelling.

Use what you know and what you learnt in context. Work will not be valid if evidence of use of automated translator.

Présentation orale

Notes are not allowed. You will use your photo album as a guide and point at your visuals.
